**Just for Sophomores** - All sophomores will get the chance to practice taking the ACT Test on Thursday, October 27 from 8:15 to 11:45. These students will take the PLAN Test, which is exactly like the ACT but geared for Sophomores. Taking this test helps students start making plans for their futures after high school by exploring career possibilities and college majors, and by looking at their academic skills and seeing in which areas they may need some additional work.

**Sophomores – Hugh O'Brian Youth Leadership Conference and Nebraska Leadership Conferences:** These two conferences are held in the summer to help sophomores develop their leadership and community service skills.

**HOBY – Hugh O'Brian Youth Leadership Seminar** is a program that brings together a select group of high school sophomores who have potential or demonstrated leadership ability. Students are introduced to distinguished leaders of the community from various sectors such as business, technology, education, government, arts, and science. HOBY's specific goals are to seek out, recognize and develop leadership potential; encourage and assist students in their quest for self-development and self-identification. This seminar will be held at Hastings College in June.

**The Nebraska Leadership Seminar** is a four-day leadership seminar where sophomores are challenged, empowered and inspired. NLS helps students grow as leaders by developing their own strengths and working with the strengths of others. This will be held at Doane College in Crete from June 14 – 17.

The cost of each of these seminars is \$150. One-half will be paid by Student Council and District OR 1, and the other half is the student's responsibility.
