Once the snow starts melting, it's time to enroll for next school year. The Juniors received their enrollment information on Wednesday during Panther pause. They will be enrolled March 8 – 11. Each student will be called in to Ms. Merryman's office to go over the transcript, to discuss possible career choices, and to begin making college and/or post high school training plans and to develop a schedule that will fit the student's educational requirements.

Sophomores will receive their information packets on Wednesday, March 10 during Panther Pause. Their enrollment forms will be due on Tuesday, March 16, and their conferences with Ms. Merryman will be the week of March 15 – 19.

Freshmen will receive their information packets on Wednesday, March 17 during Panther Pause. Their enrollment forms will be due on Friday, March 19, and their conferences with Ms. Merryman will be the week of March 22 – 26.

Current 8th graders will receive their high school enrollment information during Advisory on Wednesday, March 24. Their forms will be due Friday, March 26 and their conferences will be the week of March 29-April 1.
