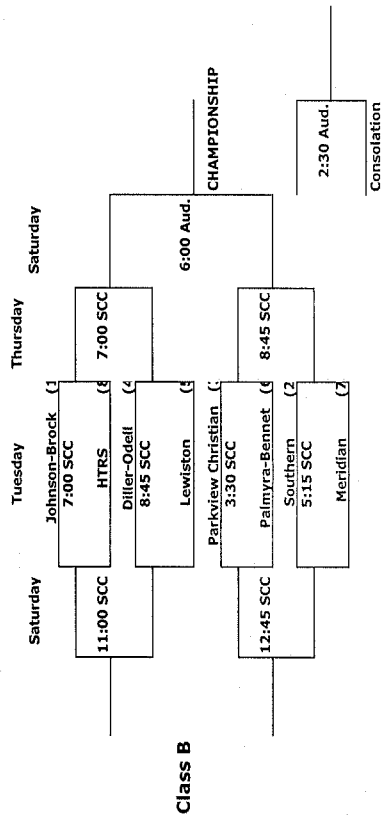

Senior Scholarships

Susan Thompson Buffett Foundation Scholarship – Applicants may start their online application process January 1 at www.buffettscholarships.org. Requirements:

- *Be an incoming freshman
- *Have graduated from a Nebraska high school
- *Be a resident of Nebraska
- *Be in need of financial assistance
- *Have achieved at least a 2.5 GPA
- *Have filed the FAFSA and received back the Student Aid Report that contains your Expected Family Contribution
- *Be attending or applying to a Nebraska state public college or university.

The absolute deadline for all scholarship materials to be turned in to the Susan Thompson Buffett Scholarship Foundation is March 12, 2012.

Southeast Community College Scholarship Program – Applicants must be US citizens graduating from high school this year. **Preference** will be given to students who rank in the top one-half of their graduating class or who have demonstrated classroom performance that would indicate potential success at SCC; however, any student planning to attend Southeast Community College next summer or fall is encouraged to apply now to be considered for the scholarships. Recipients must be enrolled at SCC. Deadline dates **December 1 through February 22.**

The Learn to Dream Scholarship funded by Southeast Community College Foundation and the Foundation for Knowledge will pay for full tuition for 45 quarter credits at any of the SCC campuses. All graduating seniors who qualify for free or reduced price lunch (as defined by the U.S. Department of Agriculture) are eligible. These applications will be available in late March – early April.
