Flu and Cold Season

Flu and Cold Season is here. To ensure the safety of everyone, here are reminders from the student handbook on sending students home and returning to school after an illness.

The conditions requiring a student to be sent home include: temperature greater than 100 F, vomiting, diarrhea, and live head lice.

Students may return to school if: fever is less than 100 degrees without fever reducer and no vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours.
