Last week during library classes, students asked Mr. Smidt if there was a way they could check at home and see if their books are AR or not. There is a way to do that. Go to <u>www.arbookfind.com</u> and select parent or student at the first screen. AR book find is a database you or your students can use to find out if your books at home have a test for them or not. Simply type in the title or author and search.

One practice my family does at home is write down the book level, the number of points the book is worth and the quiz number on the inside cover.

AR is open for students at Bennet Elementary Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 3:45 PM. Another option student can use is the Palmyra Memorial Library.
