On Thursday, Bennet students practiced safety drills (Fire Drill, Lock down and tornado procedures.)

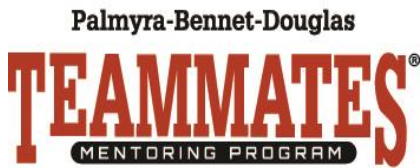
