"We are going in the right direction, .... I think the ideas are good. Want to see focus on education more than sports! I know those facilities are needed, but education is first and foremost!"
> "This bond needs to be up in November before we lose families worried we are not looking to the future."

## "One bond. November ballot. Do not wait a year."

"I think MindMixer is great but it may not meet everyone's needs. Need to try to reach people in other ways, like mail, newspaper, and displays in businesses."
