






Estimated Project Costs: PHS Option A




Estimated Project Costs: PHS Option B






General Fund Expenditures




General Fund Receipts



General Fund Levy History Total Levy vs. General Fund Levy




Expenditures and Revenue





- #2. The idea of enrollment growth at the Elementary School (20)
- #3. The idea of expanding the pre-school (19)
- #4. The idea of adding a second High School gym (16)
- #5. The idea of a multi-purpose gym/performing arts facility (15)
- #6. The idea of a new career center at the High School (14)



Five aspects that you think were <u>LEAST</u> attractive and/or acceptable to voters.

- #1. The selected location of 190th & Highway 2 as the "central site" (26)
- #2. The idea of school closings if a K-12 school is built in the future (19)
- #3. The overall cost and tax impact (18)
- #3. The idea of spending more on athletics than academics or arts (18)
- #5. The idea of a phased plan toward a single, "central site" and future new K-12 school (14)
- #6. The idea of moving 5th and 6th grades from Bennet to Palmyra (12)
- #7. The idea of a phased plan that would necessitate a future bond issue (10)

Lack of support for renovation of the 1930's building at the High School.

Is it realistic to hold a bond issue election in November? Only if there's time to provide a detailed cost analysis.

"We are going in the right direction, I think the ideas are good. Want to see focus on education more than sports! I know those facilities are needed, but education is first and foremost!"

"This bond needs to be up in November before we lose families worried we are not looking to the future." "One bond.
November ballot.
Do not wait a year."

"I think MindMixer is great but it may not meet everyone's needs. Need to try to reach people in other ways, like mail, newspaper, and displays in businesses."
