



Taxpayer Impact

"How much more would this cost me?

On a home with an assessed value of \$100,000, here's how to calculate your tax impact: **No Bond Issue:** The levy will be reduced by 5 cents. On a \$100,000 home, you would pay about **\$50 less** per year.

Bennet & Palmyra School Improvements Only (\$10.9M) The levy will be increased by 7 cents. On a \$100,000 home, you would pay about <u>\$70 more</u> per year.

Bennet & Palmyra School Improvements + Track/Practice Field (\$11.5M) The levy will be increased 8 cents. On a \$100,000 home, you would pay about \$80 more per year.

Bennet & Palmyra School Improvements + Track/Football Field w/ lights, etc. (\$12.7M) The levy will be increased 10 cents increase to your taxes. On a \$100,000 home, you would pay about \$100 more per year.


Are these the right projects?

"I agree these are the right projects. We need to make a "total" commitment to our children - whether it be in the classroom or extracurricular activities. The board plus the architects are to be commended for not throwing in the towel but thinking outside the box to identify a wide variety of options." "Why is the K-12 school off the table?"

> "What is the negative impact on our school if a second bond issue would fail?"

"What happens to the old football field with any of these plans?"

"About LPS growth... as people who live near Lincoln have valuation increases, that will help the base for our bond. We will be able to use that valuation before that land eventually moves into the Lincoln school district. Then a smaller amount of landowners will be supporting the schools. This is important because, as enrollment drops, the state aid also lessens. The district has no control over valuation, but it can bring in more students or at least keep from losing students to bring in more aid."
