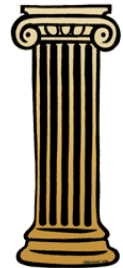
Save the Date...KDG Round Up

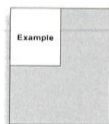

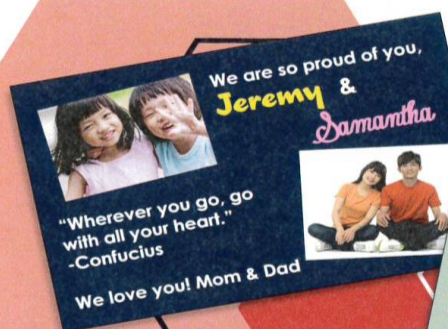

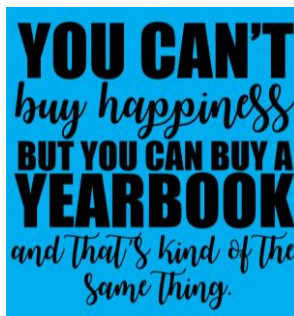
