Teachers will be sending home more information about this in the upcoming weeks. Note students will be transported by bus to the PHS Track.

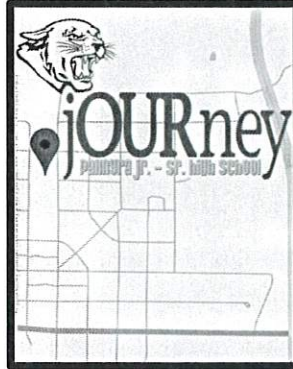
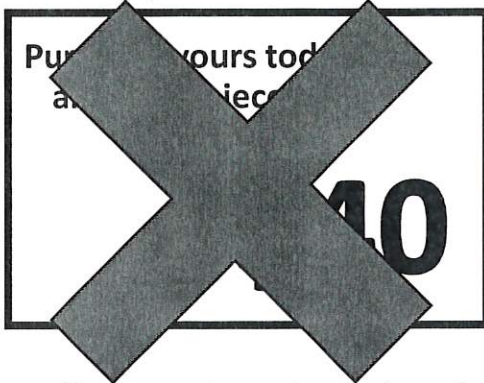

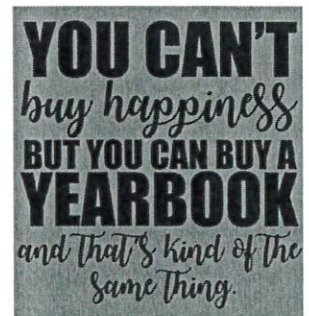
