Volleyball Protocols for visiting Weeping Water:

- Visiting teams will enter through the South Activity Entrance - bus parking is along the bus drop off/pickup curb or in the Northeast lot
- **All Visitor and Home spectators will enter through the North Activity Entrance. Visitors will enter through the west doors and Home through the east doors.**
- Visitors will sit on the north set of bleachers while home spectators will sit on the south side.
- We require spectators to use masks at all times while in the yellow color dial. If the color dial is green, each side of the stands will have a mask required and masks as an option section for spectators to choose from.
- If someone from your school (player, coach or spectator) has a medical exemption from wearing a mask, please let us know in advance.
- A concession stand will be provided with separate lines for home and visiting fans.
- Visitor restrooms are located in the hallway by the weight room on the north side of the gym with the exception of handicapped visitors who may use the lower south side restrooms. Home restrooms are located on the upper south side with handicap accessibility also in the lower south side.
- **Games will be live streamed via YouTube on WW Athletics channel**

Volleyball Protocols for visiting Louisville:

Spectators will be allowed into the competition up to 50% capacity

- Tickets will be available at the gate for home team spectators.
- As indicated by district policy, masks will be **REQUIRED** at all times for everyone, **EXCEPT** active players.

*** Spectators should social distance while at the gate and in the facility.**

- LPS will count the total number of spectators on a first come first serve basis, once the 50% capacity is reached the gate will be closed with no further access to the building.

Families should remain in the gym and not roam the facility.

- Children should sit with parents at all times.
- 6 foot spacing between families at all times.
- Strict separation of visiting crowds.
