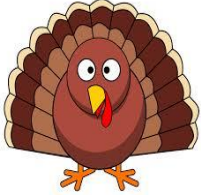

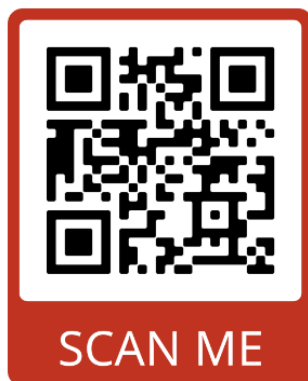

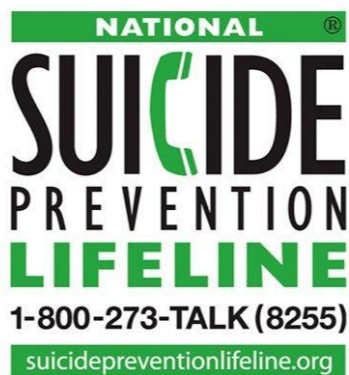

2. **Create an FSA ID.** You and a parent must each create a username and password at [fsaid.ed.gov](https://fsaid.ed.gov) that will serve as your Federal Student Aid (FSA) IDs for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You will each need your own email address to create an FSA ID.
3. **Complete the FAFSA at [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov) on or after October 1.** The FAFSA is your application for federal, state, and college-based financial aid. The colleges you list on the application will use that information to determine the types and amounts of financial aid they will award you.

**The Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles  
has created a new process in obtaining the  
Provisional Operator's Permit.**

(1) The DMV asks, but not require, that teen drivers have a legal permit prior to taking driver education. If a student is 14 by October 15, 2023, enrollment is allowed.

(2) Every student needs to successfully complete the 25 question exam given at the court house before obtaining their first driving permit.

(3) When the student has completed all course requirements, a business card and insurance waiver will be provided outlining the steps the student should take to get their POP using their home computer.

(POP is the Provisional Operator's Permit for 16 year olds)

The DMV requests that students use their home computer to print off their POP on their 16th birthday. **No need to return to the court house.**

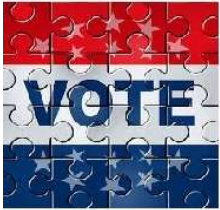

Below is a description of each position and officer duties:

**PRESIDENT:** The President shall preside at all Booster meetings, appoint all committees and shall be an ex-officio member of all committees.

**SECRETARY:** The Secretary shall keep all records, minutes of meetings, and attend to correspondences, including the notices to members of upcoming meetings or changes in regularly scheduled meetings, and notices to be posted via email and/or social media platforms.

**COMMUNICATION CHAIR:** The Communication Chair shall be in charge of the promotion of all Athletic events, updates, and other necessary communication by collaborating with the President to ensure all communication through social media platforms, emails etc. is timely, accurate and appropriate. The Communication Chair shall direct meeting discussions to provide for civil, reasonable, and full but timely discussion of topics appearing on the meeting agenda. The Communication Chair shall also ensure a final vote is taken on matters submitted by Motion.

Requirements of all officers and positions:

Officers must be active members.

The term of office shall be for a period of 2 years unless it is necessary for an individual(s) to continue as an acting officer to ensure the Booster club's continued ability to do business.

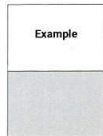
**We are also in need of someone willing to take team and individual pictures who has some photography experience (even basic) and knows or can learn basic Photo Shop editing.**

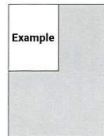
