Principal's Update

Bennet Elementary Families,

As you are aware, we take school safety and security extremely seriously at Bennet Elementary. As I previously mentioned in other newsletters, we utilize the Standard Response Protocol (SRP) for our protocols in the event of any perceived threats to staff and students. This week we practiced many of our Standard Response Protocol drills. On Monday, we practiced our lockdown drill in the event that an intruder would enter the building. On Tuesday, we practiced our Shelter (Tornado) drill in the event of inclement weather. On Wednesday, we were fortunate enough to have the Bennet Fire department to present to each class about fire prevention and safety. On Thursday, we held our bus evacuation drill. Finally, on Friday, we held our October Fire Drill to cap off our week of SRP drills. The students did a fantastic job as we practiced these essential safety drills and had fun throughout the week as we had the opportunity to walk through the Bennet Fire and Rescue ambulance and fire trucks and spend time on the school bus talking about bus safety.

I would also like to remind parents that if personal items are brought to school and something happens to these items (theft, damage, etc.) the school is not responsible or liable for these items. We ask that Pokemon cards, football cards, toys, etc. are left at home to limit the distraction in the school environment.

An additional reminder as Field Trips begin to get underway, please make sure that if you are planning to attend a field trip you go through the school background check process before attending a school event. Please contact the office if you would like to get started on the background check clearance process.

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Standard Response Protocol

Bennet Elementary's adoption of the Standard Response Protocol (SRP) provides a standardized approach to managing various events, both threatening and non-threatening, that may happen in or around our school.

These protocols provide actions for the following situations:

- Lockout (danger is outside the school)
- Lockdown (danger is inside the school)
- Evacuate (leave the school building, such as a fire)
- Shelter (tornado or severe weather)
- Hold (stay in classrooms due to a non-threatening event outside the classroom)

IN AN EMERGENCY TAKE ACTION



HOLD! In your room or area. Clear the halls.

OCCUPANTS

Clear the hallways and remain in room or area until the "All Clear" is announced Do business as usual

Close and lock door Account for occupants and staff Do business as usual

STAFF



SECURE! Get inside. Lock outside doors.

OCCUPANTS

Return inside Do business as usual

STAFF

Lock outside doors Increase situational awareness Account for occupants and staff Do business as usual



LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight.

OCCUPANTS

Maintain silence Do not open the door Prepare to evade or defend

STAFF

Lock interior doors Turn out the lights Move away from sight Do not open the door Maintain silence

Account for occupants and staff Prepare to evade or defend



EVACUATE! (A location may be specified)

OCCUPANTS

Evacuate to specified location Bring your phone Instructions may be provided about retaining or leaving belongings

STAFF

Lead evacuation to specified location Account for occupants and staff Notify if missing, extra or injured people



SHELTER! Hazard and safety strategy.

OCCUPANTS

Use appropriate safety strategy for the hazard

Hazard Safety Strategy Tornado Evacuate to shelter area

Hazmat Seal the room
Earthquake Drop, cover and hold
Tsunami Get to high ground

Lead safety strategy Account for occupants and staff Notify if missing, extra or injured people

Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

A few reminders that I would like to share to help everyone get in and out quickly:

- Please have students enter and exit your vehicle on the passenger side of your vehicle. The drop off lane is extremely effective and the safety of your student is our priority. By doing this, we can ensure that students are not in zones of traffic and are not in harm's way.
- If you are using the parent drop/pick up lanes, please stay in your vehicles. If you would like to park and walk up, please utilize the parking spaces in the interior of the parent pickup/dropoff lane.
- In the afternoon **only**, Kindergarten parents may utilize the bus drop off lane for pickup for Kindergarten students and older siblings. Grades 1-5 will continue to use the primary pickup/dropoff lane. Teachers have now been assigned zones to help aid in the location of your students to help you get in and out quickly.
- For preschool students, we have begun a student drop-off zone similar to the primary drop-off lane. If you would like to stay in your vehicle, a staff member will assist with getting your student out of the vehicle.

Arrival Times

Students that are participating in the Rec program can be dropped off starting at 7:00. All other students can arrive no earlier than 7:50 unless they are utilizing school bussing or the Rec Program. School starts at 8:20 and the tardy bell rings at 8:30. Breakfast begins at 7:50 and ends at 8:20.


PALMYRA YOUTH WRESTLING CLUB

Registration is open for all kids in grades K-8th.

The season will begin in November and continue into March. Most of the local wrestling tournaments are held on Sundays and it is optional to enter into them.
