FAFSA

1. **Attend a virtual Financial Aid Planning Program.** Learn about the various ways to fund your college education and be smart you're your resources. Here is the link to EducationQuest to learn more and register: <https://eqf.org/webinar>
2. **Create an FSA ID.** You and a parent must each create a username and password at fsaid.ed.gov that will serve as your Federal Student Aid (FSA) IDs for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You will each need your own email address to create an FSA ID.
3. **Complete the FAFSA at fafsa.gov on or after October 1.** The FAFSA is your application for federal, state, and college-based financial aid. The colleges you list on the application will use that information to determine the types and amounts of financial aid they will award you.

The Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles has created a new process in obtaining the Provisional Operator's Permit.

- (1) The DMV asks, but not require, that teen drivers have a legal permit prior to taking driver education. If a student is 14 by October 15, 2023, enrollment is allowed.
- (2) Every student needs to successfully complete the 25 question exam given at the court house before obtaining their first driving permit.
- (3) When the student has completed all course requirements, a business card and insurance waiver will be provided outlining the steps the student should take to get their POP using their home computer.

(POP is the Provisional Operator's Permit for 16 year olds)

The DMV requests that students use their home computer to print off their POP on their 16th birthday. **No need to return to the court house.**
